IN THE VINEYARD



Region

- ◆ Burgundy
- ◆ Côte chalonaise
- ◆ Bissey-Sous-Cruchaud



Terroir

- ◆ "Les Terrettes"
- ◆ South-facing
- ◆ 300m above sea level
- ◆ Clayey-marly soils
- ◆ 1 hectare



Cépage(s)

- ◆ 100% Pinot Noir



Harvest

- ◆ Hand-picked grapes

IN THE CELLAR



Winemaking

- ◆ Cold maceration for 4-7 days
- ◆ Fermentation lasts about 10 days
- ◆ No "pigeage" in order to preserve the fruit and avoid tannins extraction



Ageing

- ◆ 100% old oak barrels
- ◆ 11-12 months

TASTING



- ◆ Clear, shiny ruby colour
- ◆ Purplish highlights



- ◆ Notes of red fruits: cherry and redcurrant



- ◆ Smooth and generous on the palate
- ◆ Red fruits with soft tannins on the attack
- ◆ Cherry



- ◆ Serve at : 12-14°C
- ◆ Fresh wine to be enjoyed within 5 years
