## IN THE VINEYARD



### Region

- ◆ Burgundy
- ◆ Côte chalonaise
- ◆ Buxy



### Grape(s)

- ◆ 100% Chardonnay



### Terroir

- ◆ "Les Champs de Perdrix"
- ◆ Eastern exposure
- ◆ Clay-limestone
- ◆ 0.64 hectares
- ◆ 30 year-old vines



### Harvest

- ◆ Hand-picked

## IN THE CELLAR



### Winemaking

- ◆ Grapes are carefully pressed
- ◆ Wine is naturally clarified due to gravity



### Ageing

- ◆ 500L old oak barrels and stainless steel vats
- ◆ The proportion of each varies depending on the vintage
- ◆ 10 to 12 months

## TASTING



- ◆ Clear, shiny
- ◆ Golden highlights



- ◆ Fresh and elegant nose
- ◆ White fruits
- ◆ Acacia flower



- ◆ Fine density
- ◆ Well-balanced
- ◆ Citrus and dry fruit notes



- ◆ Serve at : 9/10°C
- ◆ Fresh wine to be enjoyed within 3 years
