- ◆ 0.57 hectares
- ◆ 30 year-old vines

- ◆ 100% Chardonnay

- ◆ Hand-picked grapes

## IN THE CELLAR



### Winemaking

- ◆ Gentle pressing
- ◆ Wine is naturally clarified due to gravity



### Ageing

- ◆ 100% 500L French oak barrels
- ◆ 50% are new oak barrels
- ◆ 10 to 12 months

## TASTING



- ◆ Clear, bright colour



- ◆ Brioche, floral aromas
- ◆ Slight toasted notes



- ◆ Powerful and round attack, compensated by iodized and mineral notes on the finish
- ◆ Well-balanced between richness and minerality



- ◆ Serve at 11°C
- ◆ Interesting cellaring potential
- ◆ People who like tension on the palate will enjoy it young
