- ◆ 100% Chardonnay

- ◆ Handpicked grapes



Terroir

- ◆ "Vignes Saint-Pierre"
- ◆ "Champs Toizeaux"
- ◆ "Charmelottes"
- ◆ South-facing slopes
- ◆ 1.03 hectares
- ◆ 50% of vines were planted in 1947
- ◆ 25% were planted in 1990
- ◆ 25% in 2007

IN THE CELLAR



Winemaking

- ◆ Gentle pressing
- ◆ Wine is naturally clarified due to gravity



Ageing

- ◆ 500L French oak barrels
- ◆ Less than 10% are made with new oak
- ◆ 11-12 months

TASTING



- ◆ Clear, shiny
- ◆ Golden reflections



- ◆ "Chalky" and hawthorn flower aromas



- ◆ White flowers
- ◆ Flinty
- ◆ Long finish



- ◆ Serve at 10/11°C
- ◆ Those who love mineral notes will enjoy it young
- ◆ It will develop buttery notes beyond 5 years
