Winemaking

- ◆ Gentle pressing
- ◆ Wine is naturally clarified due to gravity



Ageing

- ◆ 50% 500L old oak barrels
- ◆ 50% stainless steel vats
- ◆ 10 to 12 months

- ◆ Clear and bright
- ◆ Golden hints



- ◆ Powerful aroma
- ◆ Pear-mango



- ◆ Fine density
- ◆ Generous with exotic fruit notes



- ◆ Serve at 11°C
- ◆ Best enjoyed within 5 years while it is gener
