Winemaking

Cold maceration for

Purplish highlights



Notes of red fruits:
cherry and redcurrant



Smooth and generous
on the palate
Red fruits with soft
tannins on the attack
Cherry



Serve at 12-14°C
Fresh wine to be enjoyed within 5 years
