and spices



Full-bodied and
well-balanced.
Dark fruits (cherry,
raspberry), pepper notes
on the finish
Soft tannins.



Serve at 12-14°C

To drink under 5 years to preserve
the freshness of spices.
Can be kept 70 years for lovers of black fruits
